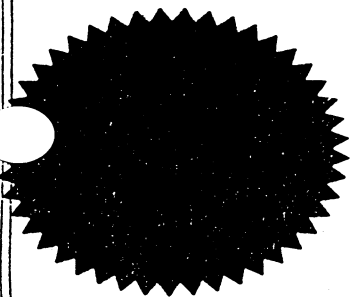
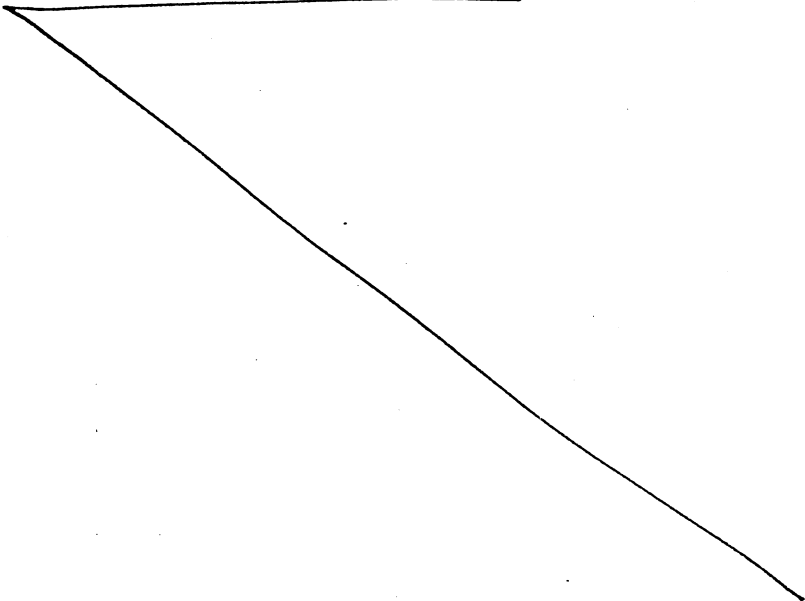

Donald M. Osgood, son of a non-Catholic father now a student for the priesthood in the Diocese of Manchester, received a dispensation from the Holy Office (# 37/48) from the impediment of Canon 987 # 1. At the time, he was a novice in the Abbey of Saint Anselm here in Manchester. He left the order subsequently and is now ready for major orders in the Diocese of Manchester.

The dispensation stated that, before receiving major orders, a new request should be submitted.

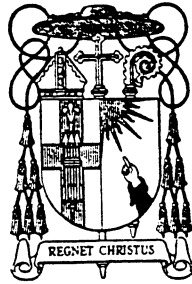

Dear Father Laframboise:

Thank you for your letter enclosing most of the documents in connection with the canonical investigation preparatory to the ordination to Tonsure of Messrs. Cameron, Hurley and Dunn. We shall await the testimonials of examination in Orders and of spiritual exercises of the two candidates from Boston (Hurley and Dunn).

In the matter of the indult required for Mr. Hurley for the impediment of Canon 1363 #1 (illegitimate birth), through some error, the Sacred Congregation of Seminaries and University Studies sent us one granting him permission to enter the seminary, rather than one permitting his advancement to tonsure. We have written again for the latter.

Under date of April 10, 1954 (Protocol # 37/US) the Sacred Congregation of the Holy Office granted to Donald Osgood a dispensation from the impediment of Canon 937, # 1 permitting him to advance "ad sacros Ordines maiores." We are sending for him another dimissorial letter for his advancement to subdeaconship and deaconship, since the previous one was dated before the granting of the indult.
