Obituary of Reverend John F. Carson

Rev. John F. Carson, Parochial Vicar of St. Ann's R.C. Church, Yonkers, NY, was called home to his Heavenly Father on the morning of August 3, 2011 at the age of 73.

Fr. Carson was born on September 27, 1937 in New Rochelle, NY to John A. and Margaret Carson. Fr. Carson was ordained on May 31, 1964 after graduating from St. Joseph's Seminary in Yonkers and has served in the Archdiocese of New York for the last 47 years. His assignments included: St. Aloysius in Livingston Manor, St. Margaret's in Pearl River, St. Peter's in Staten Island, St. Denis & Columba in Hopewell Junction, St. Francis of Assisi in Mount Kisco, Notre Dame in NYC, and St. Ann's in Yonkers.

Fr. Carson was predeceased by his parents and sisters, Jacqueline Manfrida and Frances Carson. Fr. Carson is survived by two sisters: Eleanor Carson of Warwick, NY and Dorothy- Jean Davidian of Florida, NY; several nieces and nephews and grand nieces and nephews.

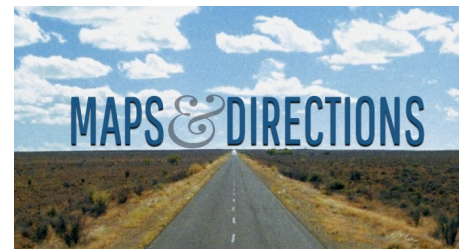

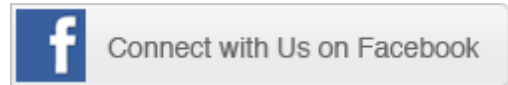
