He was born in Worcester and raised in Auburn, the son of Roland A. and Marion L. (King) Messier. He graduated from Holy Name High School in Worcester in 1959 and was later awarded a Bachelor of Arts Degree from St. Hyacinthe Seminary in Quebec. He completed his studies for the priesthood in the Grand Seminary in Montreal, Canada. He earned his Master's Degree in Theology from the American College in Louvain, Belgium and was ordained to the priesthood June 21, 1968 by Bishop Bernard J. Flanagan. He retired from active ministry in 2003.
